To avoid being a victim of fake explosion proof products from low cost countries that falsely make use of the unique ATEX EX mark, **always ask for the ATEX certification number and check the authenticity of that certification number online (<https://www.iecex-certs.com>)**. **ALL ATEX certificates are available online.**



What is known as the “ATEX certification” and uses the unique ATEX mark to show that a product complies with essential health and safety requirements is not an industry standard, it is Directive 2014/34/EU of the European Union and is widely followed by many corporates and organizations worldwide, including the military. **There are currently (April 23rd, 2024) two Fake EX models being marketed in Australia.**
