To avoid being a victim of fake explosion proof products from low cost countries that falsely make use of the unique ATEX EX mark, always ask for the ATEX certification number and check the authenticity of that certification number online (https://www.iecexcerts.com). ALL ATEX certificates are available online.



What is known as the "ATEX certification" and uses the unique ATEX mark to show that a product complies with essential health and safety requirements is not an industry standard, it is Directive 2014/34/EU of the European Union and is widely followed by many corporates and organizations worldwide, including the military. There are currently (April 23rd, 2024) two Fake EX models being marketed in Australia.
